



Airport system: traffic performance




2000 – 2015 data and 2016 forecast^(*)

2000 – 2015 data and 2016 forecast^(*)




□ Fiumicino Airport's traffic increased by approx. 14 mln pax from 2000 to 2015

□ The trend shows that the Roman airport has good resilience to extraneous negative factors and events

□ In the 2011-2016 period, passenger growth slowed slightly, with a CAGR of 2.0%

Traffic trend: Actual vs. 1st CDP sub-period 2012-2016 data





The 2012-16 traffic forecast used for the Economic Regulation Agreement ("CDP") was based on assumptions that did not consider the external crisis factors that later affected the aviation industry: economic crisis, increase of terrorism, etc.

Overall, in the 2012-16 five-year regulatory period, actual traffic remained "under" the forecast target of the CDP.

Summary of the main assumptions for the estimates shown


- The traffic forecasts relate to the second charges sub-period (2017-21) of the ENAC-ADR Economic Regulation Agreement.
- The forecast is related to both Fiumicino and Ciampino airports that together make up Rome's Airport System.
- > The forecasts were drawn up taking into account:
 - □ Historical data (actual up to 2015) and ADR's latest internal estimates for 2016
 - □ Most recent international political scenarios, reference competition and regulatory context
 - □ Market forecasts (Boeing, Airbus, ...)
 - Econometric estimates based on the performance of the main social and economic indicators
- Traffic at Ciampino airport will remain substantially at current levels, except for fluctuations of the average number of pax/movement, due to the well-known operating restrictions on the number of daily movements.

- □ The System will achieve passenger traffic growth (CAGR '15-21 +2.3%), which will also be an increase, albeit smaller, of supply (movements with '15-21 CAGR: +1,6%).
- The System's growth will be driven by development of the Fiumicino airport, while Ciampino's traffic will remain substantially steady (due to the airport's well known operating restrictions).






Fiumicino: traffic forecast

The DOM/EU component will grow at the end of the period by approx. 5 mln pax, decreasing its market share slightly vs. the total traffic


□ In 2021, the non-EU component will be approx. 2.1 mln pax more than in 2015. The '15-21 CAGR of 3.2% on the non-EU will be driven mainly by the performance forecast for the Americas ('15-'21: +4%) and the Middle East ('15-'21: +3.8%)

- □ The Ciampino airport will operate with the current number of movements due to the operating cap mentioned above (100 mov/day)
- □ The negative CAGR is due to the pax volume in 2015 that during the May-July period was increased by the flights transferred from FCO as a result of the fire event
